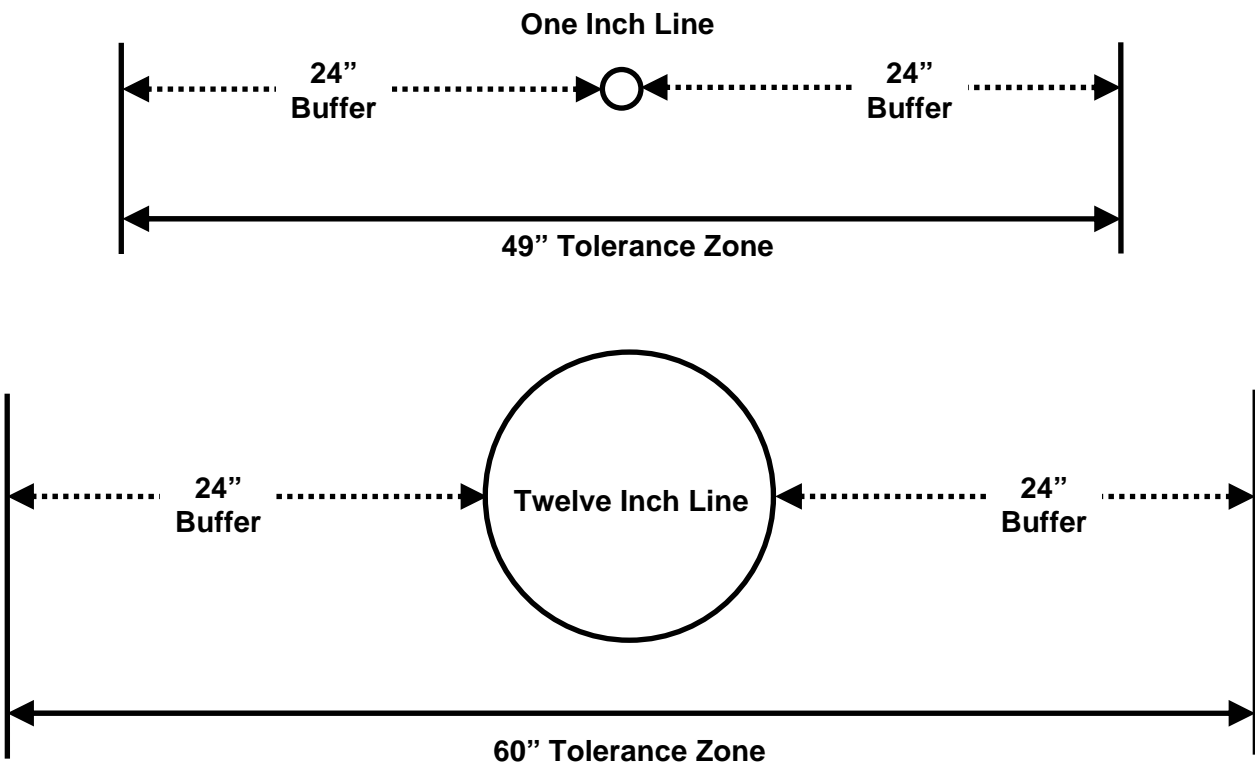


# Tolerance Zone Diagram (approximate location of subsurface installations) for California and Nevada



California Government Code 4216 (a) "Approximate location of subsurface installations means a strip of land not more than 24 inches on either side of the exterior surface of the subsurface installation. Approximate location does not mean depth." 4216.4 (a) "the excavator shall determine the exact location of subsurface installations in conflict with the excavation by excavating with hand tools...before using any power-operated or power-driven excavating or boring equipment within the approximate location of the subsurface installation"

Nevada NRS 455.082: "Approximate location of a subsurface installation means a strip of land not more than 24 inches on either side of the exterior surface of a subsurface installation. The term does not include the depth of the subsurface installation. 455.137 (1) before using any mechanical equipment, determine the exact location of a subsurface installation that is affected by the excavation or demolition by excavating with hand tools..."
